

I, Carrie E. Ward, City Clerk of the City of Riviera Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida, do hereby certify that the petition for the proposed ordinance calling for a referendum election to decide if the City of Riviera Beach shall reconsider and repeal Ordinance Number 3016, adopted by the City Council at its October 4, 2006 regular City Council Meeting bore a total of 2944 signatures of qualified electors according to the certification received from the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections. In accordance with the City of Riviera Beach Charter, Article X Section 2. Outline Commencement of Proceedings; Petitioner's Committee; Affidavit. Any five (5) qualified voters may commence initiative or referendum proceedings by filing with the City Clerk an affidavit stating they will constitute the petitioners' committee and be responsible for circulating the petition and filing it in proper form, stating their names and addresses and specifying the address to which all notices to the committee are to be sent, and setting out in full the proposed initiative ordinance or citing the ordinance sought to be reconsidered. Section 3(a) petition must be signed by qualified voters of the city equal in number to at least 15% of the total number of qualified voters registered to vote at the last election. This petition failed to comply with the above and bore a total of 413 qualified signatures of electors of the City of Riviera Beach.
